*An agent is a person who requests a ballot for another voter and may request ballots for up to two (2) voters per election.

Voter ID Information

- Valid photographic identification must have name and photo, can be expired, and can be one of the following types:
 - Nebraska Driver's License or State ID
 - United States (U.S.) Passport
 - Military ID
 - Tribal ID
 - Hospital, Intermediate Care Facility, Assisted Living Facility, or Nursing Home Record
 - Nebraska Political Subdivision ID (state, county, city, public school, etc.)
 - Nebraska College or University ID (public or private)
- If unable to get an ID because of a **reasonable impediment**, a certification can be completed instead of presenting valid photo ID. Reasonable impediments are 1) an inability to obtain a valid ID due to a disability, illness, or lack of birth certificate or other required documents or 2) religious objection to being photographed.
- Reasonable Impediment Certifications may be printed from our website or requested by contacting our office.

Submit Your By-Mail Early Voting Ballot Application

- Requests must be received by our office no later than the deadlines listed in Section 1 above.
- Return via mail/deliver to our office, fax, or email a high-resolution scanned image or picture.
- Ballots will be mailed beginning Monday, March 17, 2025 for the City Primary and Monday, April 28, 2025 for the City General.
